2015 V8 SUPERCAR CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. When are the V8's appearing at Winton?

15, 16 & 17 May, 2015

2. Can I book my ticket in advance?

Yes you can – Tickets are available online through Outix. Go to <u>winton.outix.com.au</u> and purchase tickets now. Or contact the Winton Motor Raceway office on 1800 WINTON or (03) 5766 4235.

3. Are Family passes available?

No, family passes are not available as children who are 15 years and under when accompanied by an adult are admitted free.

4. Grandstands

Reserved Grandstand seats are available and need to be purchased online through Outix. There are different packages available that include grandstand seating. One of our grandstand packages the 'Platinum Package' also includes a VIP car park directly behind the grandstand for easy access.

Children are admitted free to the circuit but if they wish to sit in the grandstand they will be need to have a grandstand ticket, which costs \$60 for the weekend and can also be purchased online. Grandstand seating can be purchased at the event form our Paddock Hut if not sold out.

5. Is concession available?

No, concession is not available due to the fact that children 15 years and under are admitted free.

6. What does a pit/paddock pass mean?

This is the area where competitor's race cars are parked. It does **NOT** include Pit Lane. Paddock passes can be pre purchased with tickets online via Outix or can also be purchased at the event form our Paddock Hut located behind the main Kiosk next to the grandstand area.

7. What time to the circuit gates open?

Gates do open on Friday, Saturday and Sunday at 6.00 am.

8. Can I camp at the circuit?

Camping is available from 8.00am Thursday 14th May 2015 and is located in a designated camping area adjacent to the back straight.

Camping is not permitted anywhere else on the circuit or circuit perimeter. Entry to the camping area is at Gate 12 on Wattle Creek Road.

9. Do we need to book a site for camping?

No. Camp sites are on a first come, first served basis.

10. How much is camping?

Purchase of camping tickets alone is not permitted. Admission tickets must be purchased at the same time as camping tickets. Camping passes can be pre purchased online via Outix or passes can be purchased on arrival. We suggest pre purchasing to guarantee your spot.

Arrive **Thursday:** \$80 per person (Children 5-10 years \$25 each)
Arrive **Friday:** \$60 per person (Children 5-10 years \$20 each)
Arrive **Saturday:** \$40 per person (Children 5-10 years \$15 each)

11. How do I get to the camping area?

Access to the camping area is via Gate 12, which is located in Wattle Creek Road at the northern end of the circuit. You must register at the site office before setting up your camp. Gate 12 is open 24 hours a day so campers are able to leave the campsite, but to regain access all campers must display a compulsory wristband.

12. Can we light a fire in the camp ground?

Camp fires may be lit but must comply with the conditions of the CFA and must be in a contained fire place as required by the Country Fire Authority (CFA).

13. Can I watch the races from the campsite?

No, only pedestrian access from the campground into the circuit is available on Friday and Saturday. Vehicle access is available on Sunday only.

14. Are there toilets, showers and power to the campsites?

Toilets and hot showers are available. There are **NO** powered sites.

15. Are there food and beverage facilities at the campsites?

Yes a kiosk and bar will be operating in the campsite for your convenience.

16. Is there access for disabled parking and facilities?

Yes, the disabled parking and toilets are located adjacent to the Media Centre. Disabled persons pay full ticket prices; an approved registered carer accompanying the disabled person is admitted free. A carer/companion card must be shown on entry.

17. Apart from the V8 Supercars, what are the support categories participating at the event?

Support categories include: Dunlop Series for V8 Supercars, ENZED Touring Car Masters, Kerrick Sports Sedan Series and Australian Sports Racer Series.

18. Are pets allowed at the circuit?

In the interest of safety, pets are **NOT PERMITTED** at the Raceway at any time.

19. Are we allowed to bring alcohol onto the premises?

Winton's Liquor Licence is for purchase of alcohol on site only. There is strictly **no BYO** and random searches of vehicles will be undertaken.
