Congratulations on securing your Cockatoo Island campsite for NYE 2019. **Please read the following information carefully** — it's your go-to guide with everything you need to know about NYE on Cockatoo Island. The celebrations will continue rain, hail or shine.

BRING YOUR TICKET AND ID

On 31 December, the island will be closed to the general public, so you will need your ticket to gain entry. Wrist bands will be issued on your arrival and must be worn while you're on Cockatoo Island.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT TIMES

31 December check-in is from **9.00am-4:00pm**. All sites must be set up by **6.00pm**. All sites must be checked-out and vacated by **12.00pm** on New Year's Day.

CAMP SITE ALLOCATION

BYO tents

• Sites for BYO tents will be allocated **sequentially**, as people arrive. If you're part of a bigger group booked under different names, please plan to arrive together so you can be sited together (provided all tickets are presented).

Pre-erected camping and glamping tents

- Our pre-erected camping and glamping tents will be allocated before you arrive. If you have booked more than one tent under one name, you will automatically be placed together. If you'd like to be with friends or family booked under a different name please email us at stay@cockatooisland.gov.au by 22 December with your ticket details.
- When checking out, please clean out your tents, and remember to take all rubbish with you. Place all equipment back as you found it, and zip up doors and windows. Don't forget to return anything you've hired to the Visitor Centre.

CATCHING THE FERRY TO COCKATOO ISLAND

If you haven't pre-purchased car parking tickets, using public transport is your best option to get to a ferry, as parking around wharves may be congested. Please check with the local council regarding NYE clearway restrictions around your preferred departure point.

- Please check the latest timetable information at transportnsw.info
- Plan your travel remembering that 31 December will be very busy, and ferries will be running to a Saturday schedule. Ferry access to the island will be limited after 4:00pm (and sometimes earlier) on NYE, due to harbour exclusion zones.
- To ensure a smooth ferry transfer, it is advised that campers pack light as the ferry will not wait for late comers.

PRE-PURCHASED PARKING AND SHUTTLE TRANSFER VOUCHER

The chartered ferry service is only available to campers with pre-purchased car parking tickets. Each voucher entitles the holder to:

- a) One car spot in our Horse Paddock parking area in Woolwich (Google Maps); and
- b) Return ferry shuttle service for up to six people between the parking area and Cockatoo Island.


Police will be blocking off the streets around Hunters Hill from Burns Bay Road off-ramp and Church Street from 1pm. You will need to show your car parking ticket to gain entry.

Please ensure you have your parking voucher displayed on your dashboard, as road access will be restricted and only parking ticket holders will be allowed entry.

The chartered ferry service will be operating from the wharf located in front of the Deckhouse Restaurant & Cafe at Woolwich Dock — just a short walk from the car parking area (during these times only):

31 December: 9am - 3pm

1 January: 7am - 12pm (only from Cockatoo Island back to Woolwich parking area)





THINGS TO REMEMBER

Ticketing and Identification

- · Print out your ticket and bring it with you to be scanned for entry.
- · The ticket holder (the person whose name on the campsite ticket) must show ID on arrival. No ticket and ID no entry.
- All guests must have a general admission ticket to access the island. A campsite ticket is not a general admission ticket.
 No ticket and ID no entry.
- · ID will be required if you wish to purchase alcohol. You'll be able to enjoy a drink by your tent, or at the picnic areas on the Eastern Apron.
- The event will continue in all weather conditions except in the case of extreme weather. Refunds due to poor weather or cancellations of fireworks are not possible.
- Bushfire smoke continues to affect greater Sydney and as a consequence air quality has been deteriorating. For most people, smoke causes mild symptoms like sore eyes, nose and throat. The Harbour Trust wishes to advise that participating in the New Year's Eve program on Cockatoo Island may not be suitable for people with existing lung and heart conditions like asthma, emphysema and angina. People with such conditions should follow their medical action plans and seek medical advice if they are concerned.

Campers Amenities

- · You'll need to supply all your own cooking utensils, cutlery and plates if you're planning to use our camp kitchen.
- · There are showers located in the City View, Woolwich View & Slipway Precincts.
- · There is a limited supply of stretchers, chairs and camping mats for hire.

Prohibited Items

- · No alcohol can be brought to the island. Bag searches will be conducted at the check-in point (penalties apply) and alcohol confiscated.
- Just a reminder amplified music, naked flames, fireworks, portable BBQs, compressed liquid or gas containers, beach umbrellas (as well as any other structures such as gazebos) pets, skateboards, drones, fishing lines or roller blades are not permitted on the island.

Amenities & Services

- · Bring cash there is no ATM on Cockatoo Island and no 'cash outs'. Limited EFTPOS is available at food vendors.
- · A limited number of coin-operated lockers are available at the Muster Station with 3-point plugs.
- · For campers bring your own lock to secure your tent.
- · Bring hats and sunscreen. There is a limited supply of toiletries, ponchos and biodegradable kitchenware packs for sale.
- Ice is available \$7 per 5kg bag from the Visitor Centre.
- · The Upper Island will be closed to campers at 7pm or as directed by security.

HISTORICAL TOURS

Convict Escape Attempts

In this 60 minute tour your guide will give you insight into what it would have been like to be a convict on Cockatoo Island. Discover the stories of failed and successful escape attempts by the convicts that lived on the island in the 1800's.

Book historical tours at the Visitors Centre on NYE

Convict Precinct Tour

During the Convict Precinct Tour, your guide will lead you through the turbulent history of the island's former penal establishment, stopping at iconic landmarks including the Mess Hall, Barracks, Guardhouse, Military Officers Quarters and Solitary Confinement Cells. You'll also hear about the history of the island's former shipbuilding yard, industrial school for girls and reformatory.

From Sandstone to Steel

This general history tour charts the changing face of Cockatoo Island. As you visit key landmarks, our guide will reveal how they fit into the island's historical narrative. They will also share anecdotes about a colourful cast of real-life characters.

Crooked Characters (fun for kids)

This 60-minute guided tour, will take you and your family on a hilarious and fascinating journey through the island's colonial history. Our guides – master storytellers that they are – will tell tales and sing songs that vividly bring to life a colourful cast of real-life characters, from petty criminals through to notorious bushrangers and true-blue ruffians.

LIVE MUSIC

Kate Wadey


Kate Monroe
